

- **6. Power source---**This product is intended to be supplied by a listed power supply indicated on the marking label. 
PREPARATION

Positioning The TV Set

Install Display on solid horizontal surface such as a table or desk. For ventilation, leave a space of at least 10cm is left all around the set. To prevent any fault and unsafe situations, please do not place any objects on top of the set. This apparatus can be used in tropical and/or moderate climates.



Antenna And Power Connections



- 1.Connect the antenna cable into the antenna input terminal at the rear panel and wall antenna socket.
- 2.Connect the power plug into the wall outlet. (The type of power plug provided may be different from the above picture for some countries.)

Inserting Batteries In The Remote Control Handset

 Remove the battery cover located on the back of the handset by gently pulling up-wards from be indicated part.



◆ Insert two AAA Alkaline or equivalent batteries, Following the +/- marking in the battery compartment.



◆ Replace the battery cover.



Precaution on battery use

Using the Remote Control



- 4. Align the stand to the back of the TV, align the holes in the TV back with the holes in the stand, then secure the stand to the TV with the screws provided.







There are two kinds of antenna in use.




- Connect the plug of the antenna cable or CATV cable to the cable (not provided with this unit), then connect to the antenna input of this unit for best reception.
- 2. If the antenna cable in your home is other than the above two, or you have problems in installing the antenna, please contact your dealer.



PERSONAL VIDEO RECORDING(PVR)

You can record DTV programmes in two ways — instant recording and timer recording. Before start recording, please insert the Media drive into the USB slot.

Instant recording (current program recording)

- 1. Select a DTV programme you desired to record, press [REC] button to begin recording. Now a control bar will appear at the bottom screen for you to control. 2. If the control bar disappears, press the [REC] button can open it again.
- 3. Select can playback the recorded contents and access time shift function.



Timer recording (Future program recording-Read EPG feature)

Check EPG to select the program you want to record. In EPG interface, you can press colored buttons to operate "Recorder", "Schedule", "INFO" and "Remind" feature according to the on-screen tips.

Note: (A) During the record mode, you cannot change channels or select another function.

- (B) If the signal is interrupted or removed while in record, the recording will stop until the signal is established. This may cause you to lose program content.
- (C) Please do not turn the TV OFF during recording. This will make the TV exit the PVR and turn to standby.
- (D) If the PVR feature fails to operate, try format your USB device through on the TV.

This TV provides PVR (personal video recorder) recording function, which allows the viewer to pause and rewind any DTV programme (that is, time shifting function), as well as record and play back selected programmes. The programme content will be recorded in a digital format onto an external memory device (such as USB device, memory card, or other mass storage device). Below all operations in this section require the external memory device be connected with the TV. Otherwise the operation can not be done.

- Before PVR recording, you need to check the external memory device's File System successfully.
- Do not disconnect the memory device from the TV while recording, or the data will be lost.
- During recording, a directory will be automatically created at the external memory device to temporarily save the data.
- The recorded contents cannot be played on any other product or computer, it also can not be played on the TV through the USB input source.
- Important Copyright Information: Unauthorized use, copying, distribution, broadcasting, public performance, lending or revision of the recorded TV programmes are prohibited.
 Please refer to your local area copyright laws for more details.
 The recorder once in time shift mode will continue recording what you are watching and
- overwrite any information already on the memory device.

 If malfunction, then information already on the memory device may lose. So please back up your
- memory device data.
- When Time Shifting, the external memory device need to write and read data simultaneously. So during the process it may occur slight picture/sound pause or standstill depending on the memory device's speed and stability.
- After recording, you can connect the memory device to your PC to delete temporary data or format a partition to completely clear those unnecessary data.
- Certain types of memory device (such as some USB devices) may not be compatible with this TV. The TV only supports FAT32 format.

ELECTRONIC PROGRAM GUIDE(EPG)

"EPG" is the abbreviation of Digital Electronic Program Guide. In the digital mode, an EPG is provided by the programme providers. To access this press the EPG button on the remote control, the EPG provides programme information for the next number of hours. Press this button, it can be displayed.

1.Press ▲/▼ ◀/▶ to select PROGRAMME GUIDE for TIME. Press ◀/▶ to choose the date you want, then the window will display the selected date channel and program name.

2.Press ▲/▼ ◀/▶ to select PROGRAMME GUIDE for a date. Press ◀/▶ to choose your desired channel, then the window will display the list of selected television programs.

3.RECORDER

Press the RED button, the recorder menu will be show. Press $\blacktriangle/\blacktriangledown$ to select an item and $\blacktriangleleft/\blacktriangleright$ to change the setting. Press the YELLOW button to enter the program to the schedule list. An updated schedule list will be shown.

4.INFO

Press the GREEN button to show information about the selected program.

5. SCHEDULE

Press the YELLOW button to display the schedule list. Press \triangle/∇ select a reminder and press the RED button to delete reminder.

6.REMIND

Press the BLUE button, a reminder setting menu will be show. Press \triangle/∇ to select an item and $\triangleleft/\triangleright$ to change the setting. Press the YELLOW button to enter the program to the schedule list. An updated schedule list will be shown.





Warm Tips:

Please be cautious to use the "SCHEDULE" & "REMIND" function. Because the time function of this TV set is not a real time clock. It is not nicety after a long time working or standby.

This section explains the menus of your TV. Each menu is outlined and detailed to help you get the most from your TV.

Turning On/Off


Insert the power cord into the wall outlet, the unit goes to standby mode, press Power button on the remote control to turn on the unit, and you will be ready to use its features. With the power on, press the Power button on the remote control to turn off the unit, and put the unit in standby mode. To cut off the power completely, pull out the power cord.

Basic Operation

- 1. Press MENU on the remote control or on the $\ensuremath{\mathsf{TV}}$ key panel to display the main menu.
- 2. Press **◄**/**▶** and **▲**/**▼** to highlight the desired menu/item.
- 3. Press **◄/▶** to change the setting.
- 4. Press MENU to save setting and go back to last menu.

Note:

- 1. Button on the key panel have the same functions as the corresponding buttons on the remote control.
- 2. The scheme and description are in TV mode as below, there will be a note if there is exception.



Picture Settings

Picture Mode

Adjusts the picture mode: Normal, Soft, Personal, Bright four kinds of image mode. "Brightness", "Contrast", "Color", "Tint" and "Sharpness" can only be adjusted when "Picture Mode" is set to "Personal". Brightness

Adjusts the brightness of the picture, and usually is adjusted together with Contrast.

Contrast

Adjusts the difference between the light and dark areas of the picture. To get better picture value, Contrast should be adjusted to the proper value.

Color

Adjusts the richness of colour. This function is not available in PC mode.

Tint

Adjust the tint of the picture.

Only can be done under the NTSC system.

Sharpness

Adjusts the sharpness of the picture. This function is not available in PC mode.

Color Temperature

Press OK button to enter the color temperature sub menu. Color Temperature Adjusts the colour temperature of the picture, to select the option: Cool, Neutral, Warm, Personal as you desired.





Neutral: About 9300k. Warm: About 6500k.

Personal: The user may customize the color temperature.

(Red/Green/Blue). Cool: About 12000k.

Display Mode
To select five modes are available including: Panoramic, Zoom1, Zoom2, 16:9,4:3 and Auto (UnderScan only in HDMI source).

DNR

To select four modes of digital noise reduction are available including Off, Low, Middle and High.

Sound Settings

Sound Mode

Equipped with User, Standard, Music, Film, News, Personal five kinds of voice mode for your choice.
"Bass" and "Treble" can only be adjusted when "Sound Mode" is set to "Personal".

Bass

Adjusts the lower frequency of the sound.

Adjusts the higher frequency of the sound.

Adjusts how much audio (loudness) gets sent to the left and right speakers. Only can be adjusted when "Surround Sound" is set to "Off".

AVL

This function may be set as On or Off. Auto Volume Level can set the volume automatically adjust corresponding to the input audio.

Surround Sound



TROUBLESHOOTING

NO PICTURE. NO SOUND

- 1. Check if the fuse or circuit breaker is working,
- Plug another electrical device into the outlet to make sure it is working or turned on.
- 3. Power plug is bad contact with the outlet.
- 4. Check the signal source.

NO COLOR

- 1. Change the color system.
- 2. Adjust the saturation.
- Try another channel. Black-white program may be received.

REMOTE CONTROL DOES NOT WORK

- 1, Change the batteries,
- 2. Batteries are not installed correctly.
- 3. Main power is not connected.

NO PICTURE, NORMAL SOUND

- 1. Adjust the brightness and contrast.
- 2. Broadcasting failure may happen.

NORMAL PICTURE, NO SOUND

- 1. Press the volume up button to increase volume.
- 2. Volume is set to mute, press MUTE to restore sound.
- 3. Change the sound system.
- 4. Broadcasting failure may happen.

UNORDERLY RIPPLES ON THE PICTURE

It is usually caused by local interference, such as cars, daylight lamps and hair driers. Adjust the antenna to minimize the interference.

BLANK SCREEN IN PC MODE

Perhaps the TV can not recognize the resolution set by the PC. Suggest to change to the best resolution or other standard resolutions of Windows system. Set refresh rate to be 60Hz.

SNOWY DOTS AND INTERFERENCE

If the antenna is located in the fringe area of a television signal where the signal is weak, the picture may be marred by dots. When the signal is extremely weak, it may be necessary to install a special antenna to improve the reception.

- Adjust the position and orientation of the indoor/outdoor antenna.
- 2. Check the connection of antenna.
- 3. Fine tune the channel.
- Try another channel. Broadcasting failure may happen.

IGNITION

Black spots or horizontal streaks appear, or the picture flutters or drifts. This is usually caused by interference from car ignition system, neon lamps, electric drills, or other electrical appliance.

GHOST

Ghosts are caused by the television signal following two paths. One is the direct path, the other is reflected from tall buildings, hills, or other objects. Changing the direction or position of the antenna may improve the reception.

RADIO FREQUENCY INTERFERENCE

This interference produces moving ripples or diagonal streaks, and in some case, loss of contrast in the picture. Find out and remove the radio interference source.
